Word Study: Unit 20 spelling – /j/ and /s/ vocabulary – airplanes

This week we will be studying word patterns that make the /j and /s/sounds. Each word this week has the /j/ sound, as in jump, or the /s/ sound, as in sing. The /j/ sound can be spelled with the consonant j or with the consonant g followed by e or i. The /s/ sound may be spelled with a e when the e0 is followed by e0 or e1.
