

Word Study: Unit 21
spelling – /k/ and /kw/
vocabulary – a play review

This week we will be studying word patterns that make the /k/ and /kw/sounds. Each word this week has the /k/ sound, as in *shark*, or the /kw/ sound, as in *quick*. The /k/ sound can be spelled with the consonants *k*, *ck*, *c* or *ch*. The /kw/ sound may be spelled with a *qu*.

/kw/ queen
