spelling – suffixes *-less* and *-ness*

This week we will be studying words made up of a base words and a suffix. A suffix is a word part added to the end of a base word. It adds meaning to the base word. The suffix *-less* means “without.” The suffix *-ness* means “the condition of.”

pain + less = **painless**

sick + ness = **sickness**
