

Dear Parents,

Our Christmas program is coming up on December 14 at 6:30 p.m. Students should arrive at Biederman Hall **NO LATER THAN 6:15**. This letter is to inform you about what your child should wear, and other details.

The name of our program is "THE GREATEST GIFT". Your student should dress in NICE, CHRISTMAS-Y clothes. No shorts, but nice jeans are okay. Girls may wear dresses, skirts, or nice pants, but **NOT LONG** skirts or dresses, please, and not TOO FANCY. **ABSOLUTELY NO HIGH HEELS**. Boys should wear nice pants and shirts. There are a few special instructions as well

KINDERGARTEN - NO SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS Santa hats are okay, but OPTIONAL!

FIRST GRADE - MICE If your child is one of the mice, it would be nice if they could wear a brown, white, tan or gray top or shirt, and pants or skirts. Or a dress of one of the above colors would work. I will provide the rest of the costume. I also will provide the **SANTA** costume. **SUGARPLUMS** could wear a tutu over leggings or pants (this is OPTIONAL!)

SECOND GRADE - Santa hats or reindeer antlers could be worn with their Christmas-y clothes (this is OPTIONAL!) I will be providing costumes for the Nativity players (Mary, Joseph, shepherds, kings)

Your student will be bringing home the words to all of our songs (except Kindergarten). It would be good if you could see that they work on learning all the words. We have been working hard in music class to memorize the songs, but some extra practice at home would be very helpful.

Again, students should arrive at the hall on December 14 no later than 6:15 p.m. (teachers will tell them where to meet). We are looking forward to a fun evening!
