Family Children will learn about coins and their values by handling them, sorting them, matching them, helping you pay for items, and collecting change. Look for opportunities for your child to help you handle and use real money. Allow your child to empty a coin purse, search your pockets, or look under the couch cushions to find coins at home. Have him or her practice matching and sorting the coins, taking care to notice both sides of the coins.
