VOCABULARY TO KNOW

1. Catholics: baptized Christians who follow the leaders of the Church: the pope and bishops
2. Good News: another name for the Gospels; the news that Jesus is our Savior.
3. Sacred Scripture: another name for the Bible, the written word of God
4. Faith: the power to trust in God and believe in Him
5. Incarnation: the mystery of God's becoming human
6. Pope: the visible head of the Church; he represents Christ
7. Jesus: our Savior, the one who perfectly reveals God the Father
8. Baptism: the sacrament which first gives us a share in God's life.

IDEAS TO KNOW

1. Peter was the first pope.
2. God reveals himself through creation, through the Scripture, through the Church, and through Jesus his Son.
3. There are three persons in God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
4. We are all disciples; we are all to talk about God and spread the Good News.

PARTS OF SCRIPTURE

1. The Old Testament tells us about God's love for his Chosen People, before Jesus came.
2. The New Testament tells us about Jesus, his life and teachings and about the early Church.
3. The Book of Psalms contains prayer-songs.
4. The Acts of the Apostles tells about how the Holy Spirit guided the early Church.
5. The Book of Revelation is the last book of the Bible; it tells us about God's kingdom in heaven.
6. The Gospels tell us about Jesus' life and teachings.
