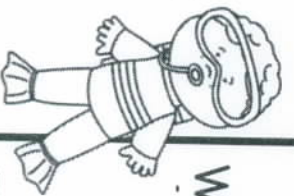


Ocean Life

A lobster can be in the ocean. It is little.



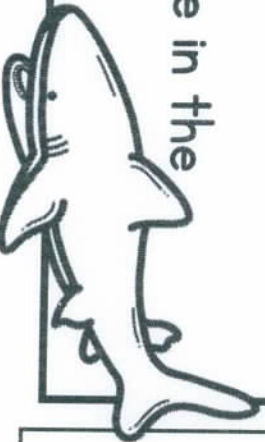
The turtle can be in the ocean. It is little.



The octopus can be in the ocean. It is little.




Yikes! A big shark can be in the ocean, too!

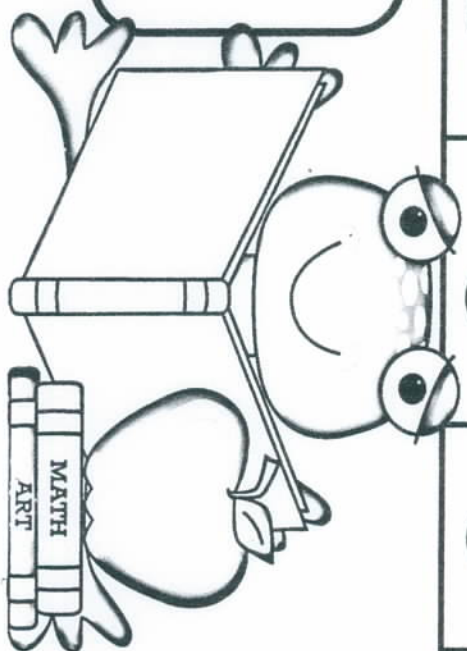

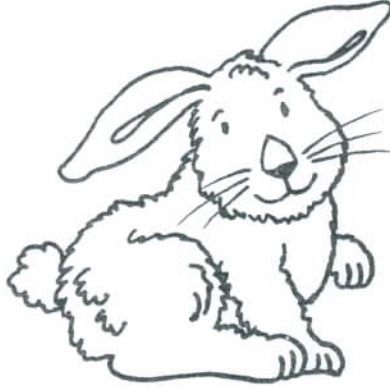
